




Open up Garage Band

Drag track to edit




Drag Audio file





 GarageBand includes a metronome, which plays a steady beat to help you play and record in time.


To use the metronome:

 To turn the metronome on or off, click the Metronome button, or choose Control > Metronome.






Put play head over area you want to adjust, then split. Play use spacebar


