Movie Dub assignment

You are given a video clip form Lorax and your job is to dub sound into the clip.

- 1. The video that you receiving in an MOV format, you are to import this clip into I movie. (when you create a movie make it 16:9 not 4:3. Make it 30 fps NTSC and give it an appropriate name not New Project.
- You are now going to study the clip and create a storyboard. On this story board you are going to plan the speech that you are going to record as well background noise, no detail is too small to plan.
- 3. Using the sound booth record the text that you want to use as well as any other noises.
- 4. Sounds that cannot be produced in the class room can be downloaded from the internet. Try to limit this as you need audio portions from produced in the class room.
- 5. Once you are done editing be sure to Export the movie as a QuickTime Movie and put that file with your name and assignment number onto Mr. Regier's portable hard drive.

Rubric

Marks will be grades on the quality of the audio attached to the video. You are responsible for synchronizing all dialogue and background noise. In addition you are to pull the scenes together so that they tell a story. Plan ahead for best results and try to keep your editing to yourself so that we can all enjoy the product for the first time when we watch your presentation in front of the class.
